Conditions of Entry

I, _____ accept the following Conditions of Entry:-

- Entrants must reside, be educated, or work within the Kiama Municipality
- Entrants will be interviewed on stage in front of judges from the local community and an audience.
- All entrants will be asked a combination of questions about their hobbies, interests, ambitions as well as the questions in the form provided.
- The judges will be looking for well-presented girls who are confident in themselves, speak well in public and girls who display an interest in the local community, farming and agriculture and the Kiama Show. Entrants, Parents and Carers are to be reminded that the Junior Showgirl Competition is not a beauty pageant and therefore girls will not be judged on their physical appearance.
- There will be an informal on-stage interview that will be no longer than 5 minutes and a formal face-to-face interview that will go for about 15 minutes.
- Judging will take place on Tuesday the 21st of January 2020.
- The winners will be announced at the Showgirl presentation at 6pm on Friday the 24th of January 2020 in the main ring.
- It is a condition of entry that the entrant waives any right to claim against the Kiama Show Society, competition organisers or any sponsor or provider of prizes in connection with loss or injury suffered by the entrant or in relation to the decisions and directions of judges, stewards, officials or Kiama Show Society members.
- It is a condition of entry that in the event of the entrant suffering injury or loss or claim for compensation as a result of the entrants' actions, the entrant will fully indemnify the Kiama Show Society and the Competition organisers at all competition levels including any sponsor or provider of prizes, judges, stewards or officials.
- The entrant will exercise reasonable care when performing tasks in a way that ensures the health and safety of themselves and others and will comply with the Work Health and Safety Rules of the Kiama Show Society.
- The entrant must disclose any medical condition/s reasonably expected to restrict tasks to be undertaken during the Kiama Show. The required information includes but is not restricted to dietary requirements, allergies, existing medical conditions and emergency contact details.
- Failure to comply with any of the above regulations may result in disqualification from the Competition.
- The entrant understands that any aspect of the competition may be subject to change/amendment or cancellation at any time.
